TRX Art Competition Rules and Regulation

1. Theme of the Competition

TRX City Sdn Bhd (TRXC), in collaboration with Department of Environment Federal Territory Kuala Lumpur (DOE WPKL), is organizing a sketch competition, to provide a platform for young Malaysians to express their vision for Kuala Lumpur's sustainable future through creative visual arts. Entitled "**Sustainable Kuala Lumpur**", the entries should explore the ideals of urban sustainability and how they can be reflected in our city in the future. The sketches should depict Kuala Lumpur, inclusive of future Tun Razak Exchange (TRX) development, and may include existing landmarks of the city or other structures that are conceptualized by the contestant. Open to college and university students nationwide, the TRX Art Competition is in line with the development of the green and environmentally sustainable international financial district.

2. Entry Requirement

This art competition is open to all Malaysian tertiary students 16 years of age or older.

3. Originality

You must be the sole creator of the art that you submitted for the competition. We reserve the right to request proof that your entry is your original artwork created solely by you. Non-compliance to this rule will be a disqualification of your entry. However, should the issue of copyright infringement arise only after your work passes the organizer's vetting, you will be the sole bearer of any legal instruction/implication.

4. Entry Fees

No entry fees will be imposed.

5. Repeat Entries

Contestants can send multiple entries. However, each contestant is entitled to win one (1) prize for this competition.

6. Judging

Judges' decision is final. Correspondence will not be entertained.

7. Ownership

TRXC will hold ownership of artwork submitted by the contestants of the competition.

8. Permissions of usage

Pursuant to the above item 7, TRXC shall be entitled to reproduce images of the submitted artwork on related websites, social media platforms, newsletters and/or in the future art competitions. TRXC hereby grant a non-exclusive license to use the submitted artwork for the same purpose to the DOE KL.

9. Sketch size and format

Your sketch needs to be A3, drawing block.

10. Drawing tools/materials

You have the liberty to use any physical drawing tools/materials of your choice to create your sketch. No digital tool is allowed. Your sketches must be delivered to the organizer in the hard-copy form.

11. The Entry Process:

Step 1: Read and understand the Rules and Regulations.

Step 2: Complete and sign the Entry Form.

Step 3: Create your art – be as creative as you want, but remember to tie your work with the core theme.

Step 4: Scan your sketches and Entry Form and e-mail them to mat@doe.gov.my before posting/delivering your sketch hard-copy.
