### **PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURE ON JALAN BARAT AND FULL ROAD CLOSURE AT THE EXIT ROUTE FROM JALAN BARAT TO JALAN SULTAN ISMAIL FOR CONSTRUCTION WORK OF THE TUN RAZAK EXCHANGE (TRX) DEVELOPMENT**

**KUALA LUMPUR, 15 February 2018** - Part of Jalan Barat and the exit route from Jalan Barat to Jalan Sultan Ismail will be experiencing traffic flow diversion and closure as shown in the map.

This is to enable the road upgrading works for the infrastructure construction at the Tun Razak Exchange (TRX) development.

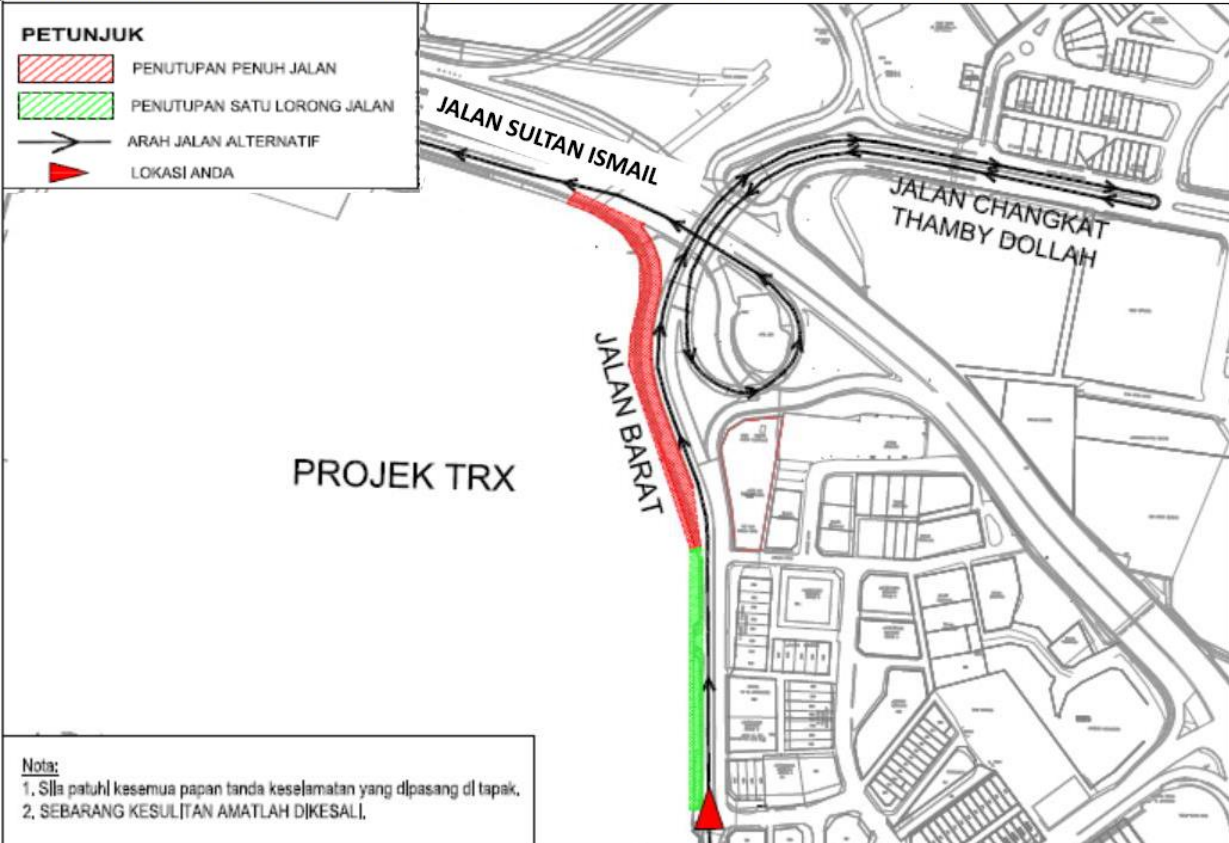
The temporary road closure on Jalan Barat and the full road closure at the exit route from Jalan Barat to Jalan Sultan Ismail will take effect continuously for **24 hours daily**, for **3 months from 16<sup>th</sup> February 2018 to 15<sup>th</sup> May 2018**.
